



Code of conduct

As 24/7 squad you are required to adhere to this Code of Conduct. Please sign this copy of the code of conduct to indicate your understanding and compliance and bring it with you to Convention.

This Code of Conduct applies to all volunteers working within Southern Cross Educational Enterprises Ltd.

I agree to:

- Honour God and his Word in all that I do
- Follow the official ACE Student Convention Guidelines
- Promote the safety and welfare of participants
- Focus on competitors effort and performance rather than winning or losing
- Abide by the ACE Student Convention Dress Code at all times including arrival at and departure from Convention.
- Attend devotions and meetings for Squad as required
- Willingly complete any tasks
- Do nothing that may have the appearance of sin i.e. not be alone with a member of the opposite gender; to be in my allocated dormitory/room at lights out unless required for specific tasks under the supervision of SCEE Staff or Squad Captains
- Accept and follow directions from SCEE Staff or Squad Captains and seek guidance through clarification where I may be uncertain of tasks or requirements.
- Observe work practices which avoid unnecessary risks
- Report any problems, including incidents, injury or property damage, as they arise to the Convention Coordinator or Squad Captains.
- Respect the rights, dignity and worth of every person regardless of their abilities, gender, doctrinal beliefs or culture background. Romans 12:3 "For I say through the grace given unto me to every man that is among you not to think of himself more highly than he ought to think, but to think soberly, according as God has dealt to every man the measure of faith."
- Always behave appropriately, including:

- No swearing or ungodly speech, derogatory terms, sexual jokes or innuendos will be tolerated. Eph 4:29 "Let no corrupt communication proceed out of your mouth, but that which is good to the use of edifying, that it may minister grace unto the hearers."
 - No special favours/relationships, always act in accordance with roles and ACE Student Convention Guidelines. Romans 2:11 "For there is no respecter of persons with God."
 - There should be no need for any physical contact between 24/7 Squad and students.
 - Any counselling is to be done with an 'open door'. Males are to counsel males and females to counsel females. I Thess 5:22 "Abstain from all appearance of evil."
- Not supporting bullying or harassment by anyone to anyone, including amongst children. Luke 6:31 "And as ye would that men should do to you, do ye also to them likewise."
 - Report any problematic behaviour to SCEE Staff who will then advise the students' Sponsor.
 - Report any illicit use or supply of substances. Any prescribed medication that may interfere with the ability to work must be reported to the Manager of the Schools Department.
 - Appropriately use email/web/mobile phones/photography or any other form of written or electronic communication. Pornography or items of a sexual nature will not be tolerated.
 - To ensure that completed judges forms, scores, and any places awarded are kept confidential.
